Reading in year 4...

To be in with a chance of winning, a grown up must have signed the reading record book the night before. Children should change their book during Wake up Brain time.



Homework.

Spelling Homework will be sent out on a Monday evening. Children are expected to practise spellings by writing them out. It would also be beneficial for your child to put the spellings into sentences. This will help with sentence structure and the use of punctuation.

Homework will also be sent out on a Monday and should be returned Friday morning of the same week. The Homework will be linked to either literacy, maths or topic work.
