They should use the images, colours and characters from the Disney Film as inspiration for their own piece of art work. They should choose their own medium, with support, to create a piece of art work based on the theme (e.g. a drawing, a painting, a collage, a junk model).</p> <p>Literacy links: Character descriptions - fictional characters</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children design their own mythical creature. Children design the setting inspired by the music / images / colours. Children to design their own Disney character and could make this (e.g. from junk modelling or modelling clay) Create a collage with a focus on colour and texture. 	<p>A and D</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To use drawing and painting to share idea, experiences and imagination. To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape. <p>Focus Key Skills Objectives</p> <p>L1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can show my ideas e.g. drawing, making a simple model and talking to someone about them. I can talk about how I feel about my own or somebody else's work. E.g. tell someone what I like about their work. I can think of ways to improve my own work. I can hold and use a paintbrush. I can mix paints. <p>L2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can compare my work to others (e.g. other children's or famous artists) I can combine observations with elements from my imagination. I can use paint in different ways for different effects. I can control my paint brush to produce clear lines and shapes. I can mix a range of secondary colours using primary colours. I can combine several different colours in printing to create different effects.
