		<p>Focus Key Skills Objectives</p> <p>L3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use a range of sources e.g music, film, stories, as inspiration for my artwork. I can use shape, colour and tone/ shading to begin to give depth/ 3D qualities to my drawing/ paintings. I can mix a range of different shades of colours in paint, including warm and cool colours. <p>L4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can explain why some techniques in my work are better than others. I can keep notes in my sketch book which explain how I might further develop and adapt my work. I act upon these notes to improve my work. I can choose the appropriate drawing tools/ materials to use for a particular effect. E.g. pencil type, charcoal I can mix and use appropriately different shades and tones of paints.
