

- What happens to super worm in the story?
- Can you tell a grown up what happens in the story?

- Can you make a story picture of your favourite part?

Maths

Using the story, **the Super Worm**

- **First make a super worm puppet/teaching aid.**
(Draw one and cut it out/ print one from the internet/ make one (felt, cardboard, old sock!) or playdough)
- **Give your child problems to solves which involve:**
 - Measuring**
 - Can they find things longer or shorter than their super worm?
 - Can they place 3 items or more in order by their length?
 - Can they identify objects and say 'this is longer than....'?
 - Find real worms and measure against their super worm.

Other ideas

Make a wormery



You will need:

- Clear container (empty large plastic bottle with top cut off, jug, sweet/food container)
- Soil and sand
- Water
- Worms

1-Find your worms (about 4)

2-Add soil and sand in layers to your container. Add a little water.

3- Add your worms to the top and watch them disappear down your wormery.

Squirmy Jelly Worms

Pack Straws into a cup and secure with a rubber band

Pour in Jelly carefully

Once Jelly is set rinse with some warm water to release the "Worms" from their straws!
