Choose your favourite story

- Read/share/listen to the story together
- Can you tell a grown up what happens in the story?
- What is your favourite part?
- Can you make a story map of the story?

My favourite story is: The Tiger who came for tea.

For this book I would:

- Have a tea party with my toys
- Make stick puppets of the characters
- Make a tiger mask
- Sort all the tins and packets in the cupboard by size/shape/weight
- Practice capacity by filling containers with water (full, empty, half full, fullest)
- Act out being a tiger - can I prowl like one?
- Have a role play cafe

Maths – Number blocks

Who is your favourite?

Choose a number and explore all about him.

- How blocks is he made from?
- Find items which could live in his number land?
- What shape could live in his land? (3=triangle, 4 =square)
- Can you find the numeral around you home? How can you spot?
- Can you count to that number?
- What happens if you add more or take some away from the number?
- Can you make him? (playdough, boxes, coloured paper, paint)

If children are confident with using numbers 1 to 10, move onto higher numbers.

Can you practice the following? If your child is able to do the following it will help them be more independent in September for full time school.

- Putting on your own coat
- Putting on your own shoes
- Using the toilet on your own
- Washing your own hands
- Using a knife and fork
- Using a cup to drink from
- Carrying a tray (this helps with lunchtimes)
- Opening packets in lunchboxes
- Writing your name (full name if you can)
- Know where you live
- Know your birthday
- Know how old you are
