Dear Families,
Happy New Year! What a start to 2021!
PLEASE STAY SAFE – this is my wish for everyone and if we all make a New Year's Resolution of looking after each other then we shall be fine. I led an INSET day on Monday to prepare our team for the new term. I did say 'things may look different in a week or 2.' Then at 8pm that night we heard the devastating yet essential news that we must close to the **vast majority of pupils**.

I must again ask you to consider the following before requesting a school place for your child:

1. If it is at all possible for children to be at home, then they should be.
2. If a child needs specialist support, is vulnerable or has a parent who is a critical worker, then educational provision will be available for them.
3. Parents should also do everything they can to ensure children are not mixing socially in a way which can continue to spread the virus. They should observe the same social distancing principles as adults.

We are also attempting to secure more devices to loan out to families where children have limited electronic device access. The Government has promised more; I look forward to this promise being fulfilled. I must say a massive thank you to staff for their hard work during this very strange, stressful and different start to the new year. Several have understandable worries and I remain committed to making their work as stress free as is possible - not easy at present of course. Their determination with the online learning has been great. The distribution of food and devices to our families has been equally as successful. Our school is a very special place to be and one reason is because of the highly skilled, resilient and caring staff team we have.

Please have a **safe** weekend and look after each other, especially our elders. I hope several Grandparents and Great Grandparents have received a vaccination as this looks to be the road back to 'normality.' Take great care.
