What should I already know?


- To understand how Muslims, show respect for one another such as how they greet each, honesty, kindness and good manners.
- That family is important to Muslims and that is why they live as an extended family.
- That birth is a time for celebration and recognise how a new baby is welcomed into a Muslim family.
- Identify some ways Muslims take responsibility for their community
- Understand that a mosque is a special place for Muslims to worship and know some of the rules such as covering your head, removing shoes and washing.

What will I know by the end of this unit?

- Understand that the Qur'an is a special book for Muslims and demonstrate how we show respect to the Holy book.
- Listen to some special stories from Islam and understand their meaning and the impact on the Muslim faith.
- Understand that a Mosques is a special place of worship for the Muslim faith, describe its features and the rules for visiting a Mosque.
- Understand that daily prayers are important to Muslims and that they pray using a prayer mat.

Our learning

Mosque - Muslims worship in a mosque. Muslims go to mosque to pray several times a day. The most important weekly service is held on a Friday. Muslims can pray anywhere as long as it is clean. This helps them keep salah.



Inside a mosque there is often a school where people can learn the Arabic language. This is the language that the Muslim holy book (the Qur'an) is written in.



Muslims show respect to the Qur'an by:

- washing their hands
- wrap it up when not in use
- always place it on a stand or shelf

The Qur'an teaches Muslims how to live a good life by:

- worship only one God
- pray 5 times a day
- give to charity
- show respect and love to your parents
- show forgiveness to others
