What should I already know?

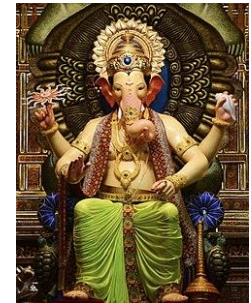
- to recognise Hindu stories, contain important values, recap the story of Rama and Sita and the meaning.
- show awareness of Janmashtami festival
- show awareness of Hindu festivals and that celebrations can be a sign of faith
- Show awareness of what happens at a Hindu wedding celebration and make Mehndi designs. Make links to other faiths.
- recognise the importance of celebrating special events with others, collectively - sample some traditional Hindu foods.

What will I know by the end of this unit?

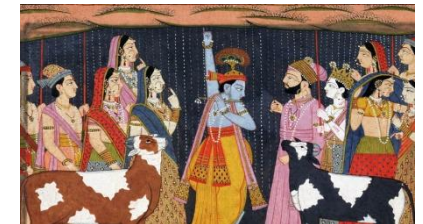
- Recognise that some stories are special to Hindus-Know the story of how Ganesh got his head. Understand why this story is special to Hindus acknowledge what can be learned from this story and make links to our own life. Show respect for other faith stories.
- Make links between own lives and ideas found in Hindu stories - Listen to the story of a Race around the world. Understand the meaning of the story? Make links to my own life. Understand the importance of family to the Hindu faith and respect for your elders.
- Continue to understand that Some stories are special to Hindus - Recognise why Shiva is special to the Hindu faith and make links with Shiva and the story of creation.
- Discuss similarities and differences between the Hindu story of creation and the Christian story of creation.
