

NATIONAL CURRICULUM

What should I already know?

1. Understand that the Qur'an is a special book for Muslims and demonstrate how we show respect to the Holy book.
2. Listen to some special stories from Islam and understand their meaning and the impact on the Muslim faith.
3. Understand that a Mosque is a special place of worship for the Muslim faith, describe its features and the rules for visiting a Mosque.
4. Understand that daily prayers are important to Muslims and that they pray using a prayer mat.

What will I know by the end of this unit?

1. To know Allah is Islamic name for God and he helps Muslims live their lives through Qur'an.
2. Revisit learning on Mosques and understand that a Friday is a call to prayer.
3. Understand the 5 daily prayers, times and actions.
4. To know that each Mosque is connected to the Holy city Mecca.
5. To understand that a Muslim must try to complete a Hajj to Mecca once in their life time.
6. Describe what happens during the Hajj.


Our learning

- *Sacred Texts:* The Qur'an is the holy book for Muslims. Muslims believe it is the perfect word of Allah. Muslims believe that Allah recited the Qur'an to the last prophet, Muhammad (pbuh). Over 22 years, Muhammad received revelations from Allah. These revelations were written down as the Qur'an. He is recognised as the founder of Islam. Muhammad taught: "There is no God but Allah."



- *Special Places:* The Muslim place of worship is a mosque. Al Haram Mosque - Mecca, this is largest mosque in the world and is home to one of Islam's holiest places, the Kaaba. Wherever they are in the world, Muslims always pray in the direction of this special place.
