What should I already know?

1. To recognise and describe the 5 pillars of Islam.
2. To Understand that Shahadah means that there is only one God who is Allah.
3. Understand Salah - that Muslims must pray 5 times a day.
4. Recognise Zakat - the importance of giving part of your wage to charity.
5. Demonstrate an understanding of Sawm -that Muslims fast during Ramadan.
6. Understand that Muslims must make a pilgrimage to the Holy city of Mecca at least once in their life and this is called the Hajj.
7. To consider the impact of the 5 pillars on the Islamic way of life.


What will I know by the end of this unit?

1. To understand the importance and rituals of the holy month of Ramadan.
2. Create a timeline for a day in the life of a Muslim during Ramadan, to help understand the purpose and impact of Ramadan.
3. To understand how Muslims practice, restrain during Ramadan.
4. Research and discuss foods that Muslims eat and how they celebrate the end of Ramadan.
5. Understand that Muslims eat and prepare food that is Halal.
6. Discuss Britain as a society of many religions and talk about the impact of Ramadan on the Muslim faith.

Our learning

Islamic rules/law according to the Qur'an: Muslims strive to carry out the Five Pillars of Islam, which require many rules to be obeyed, these include:

- show their declaration to Allah (Shahadah)
- halal food
- wearing special clothing (burka, hijab, etc.)
- contribute to charity (zakah)
- praying 5 times a day (salah)
- no alcohol, illegal drugs or gambling
- performing wudu



Special Festivals: Hajj is a pilgrimage to the Kaaba in Mecca and is one of the Five Pillars of Islam. Muslims will aim to visit the Kaaba at least once in their lifetime. Special clothes, ihram, are worn to show everyone is equal.



Several rituals are completed during this often-week-long event. Once completed Muslims are given a new title known as 'Hajji'.
