How does my child select their food?

Meals should be ordered by the parent using Parent Pay and can be selected up to two weeks in advance. Each class has a copy of the school menus.

How much does a school meal cost?

School meals are £2 per day = £10 per week

The School Debt Policy

<u>Debt Management Procedure - School Lunches</u>

- Payment should always be made in advance of a lunch being taken.
- If a child orders a school meal and there is no money on the account, a text or phone call will be made requesting that payment is made ASAP. This will continue each day.
- If the debt reaches £6, a letter will be sent home with the child to ask parents to make payment immediately, or to arrange a meeting with the Head of School.
- Parents must send in a healthy packed lunch until the debt is paid, as no more school dinners will be provided and future dinners should be paid for in advance.
