<u>Time</u> Time sentences are different in French. e.g. <ul style="list-style-type: none">Instead of saying 'It's 3 o'clock', in French we say 'It is 3 hours'.Instead of saying 'It's half past 5', we say 'It is 5 hours and a half'	What time do you learn...?	À quelle heure tu apprends?

<u>Asking questions</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Time questions (What time...?) can either start with Quand (When) or À quelle heure (At what time).There are different ways of forming questions in French.<u>Sometimes</u> in questions, the pronoun and the verb are swapped around. e.g. Aimes-tu la musique? the word 'like' comes before the word 'you'.
