



Our School Improvement Priorities

As a school we are constantly reflecting on our practice and seeking to improve what we do for our children and our community.

Our school priorities this year are:

Teaching:

- Develop the teaching of **maths** including to improve children's automatic recall of key knowledge and facts through the introduction of daily 'maths meetings'
- Develop our teaching of **Working Scientifically** to develop pupils' skills of carrying out scientific investigations and enquiry
- Develop a **language** rich environment and high quality interactions and questioning

Curriculum:

- Develop a progressive and clearly sequential curriculum for **writing** to ensure the key fundamental knowledge is taught in each year group and applied in a range of high quality writing outcomes
- Develop a clearly designed teaching sequence in each unit of study for **art, geography and science**
- Develop the **mathematics** curriculum through the Early Years to ensure clear progression from Foundation 1 to Foundation 2.

Community:

- To **improve attendance** and support families to reduce persistent absenteeism
- Provide greater opportunities for **parents** and families to be involved in and **know about their children's learning** and wider involvement in school

Leadership:

- Develop **subject leaders** as 'experts' within their field
- Develop the **new senior leadership team** in school into their roles
- Develop **student leadership** roles including the successful implementation of our Anti-bullying Ambassadors
- Ensure **high quality CPD** for all staff
- Ensure the **pace and rigor of learning** throughout the day
