

Our School Improvement Priorities 2023-24

As a school we are constantly reflecting on our practice and seeking to improve what we do for our children and our community.

Our school priorities this year are:

Teaching:

- Develop language and oracy skills across the curriculum, including developing pupils' understanding and use of a wide range of vocabulary
- Develop teacher questioning and the use of formative assessment to adapt lessons to meet the needs of all pupils
- Develop the teaching of working scientifically so that pupils have the knowledge and understanding to carry out and record findings from their own science investigations
- Continue to develop the teaching of mathematics with a focus on automatic recall of number facts and problem solving and reasoning
- Develop practical maths opportunities in EYFS

Curriculum:

- Develop high quality task selection and use of high quality resources across the curriculum, including opportunities to read a range of high quality and challenging books across all subjects
- Implement the new writing curriculum across KS1 and KS2 to support high quality writing outcomes
- Develop a clearly designed teaching sequence in each unit of study for history, design technology and music

Community and Partnerships:

- Develop a Parent Forum which allows parents/carers to have a stronger voice and representation in school
- Develop playground provision for children including quiet spaces and the use of sports leaders to organise group games at playtimes
- Develop student leadership including reading ambassadors, maths champions, anti-bullying ambassadors and well-being ambassadors
- Develop opportunities for parental involvement in children's learning in EYFS

Leadership:

- > To improve attendance and support families to reduce persistent absenteeism
- Develop subject leaders' understanding of the quality of teaching and outcomes within their subject
- Develop subject leaders' to be able to deliver high quality training for their subject
- Develop the Local Governing Body's knowledge of the curriculum and standards across school
