Understand that Allāh is the ‘one God’ – the creator/provider who sends humankind guidance through the words of the Qur’ān. Discover some of the 99 names of Allāh and their meanings. Look at some Arabic scripts and think about reasons why Muslim children are taught Arabic - Discuss/bring a special book and describe why it is special to them.</p>	<p>I understand that Allah is the Islamic name for God in the Arabic language.</p>
<p>Week 2 Q2. Why are some places special? Local places of worship, objects, artefacts, signs and symbols, sacred sites and pilgrimages.</p>	<p>LO: Recognise and respond thoughtfully to the Mosque as a place where Muslims worship Allāh.</p>	<p>Investigate internal /external features of a Mosque. Visit a Mosque/ take a virtual tour/ look at pictures of the inside and outside of a Mosque. Find out about a Mosque as a place of worship: - Call to prayer - Preparations for entering the Mosque - Friday congregational prayers - The Mosque as a social, religious and welfare centre. Listen to a recording of the call to prayer. Watch a video extract showing prayers in a Mosque - Look at pictures/posters etc, of prayers in the Mosque and the Ka’bah - Islāmic patterns - A compass.</p>	<p>I can describe some external and internal features of a Mosque.</p>

How can faith contribute to community cohesion?</p> <p>Beliefs, ethics, family traditions and faith in the community.</p>	<p>LO: Recognise and describe the Five Pillars of Islām.</p>	<p>Recognise and describe the Five Pillars of Islām: - Shahādah (declaration of faith) - Salāh (prayer) - Zakāh (alms giving) - Sawm (fasting) - Hajj (pilgrimage to Makkah).</p> <p>The Five Pillars of Islām and their effect on the lives of Muslims: - Praying five times a day - Importance of facing in the correct direction when praying as reminded on the prayer mat - Modest style of dress - Specific dietary laws based on religious beliefs - Duty to pay Zakāh.</p> <p>Consider the impact of the Five Pillars - what would change if everyone did these things?</p>	<p>I name and describe the 5 pillars of Islam.</p>

Why are some times special?</p> <p>Festivals and families.</p>	<p>LO: Further my understanding of the fourth pillar of Islām.</p>	<p>Understand that fasting in Ramadān is an important duty for Muslims and can affect all areas of their daily life: sleep patterns, physical activity, intellectual performance etc</p> <p>Use local newspapers to find sunrise, sunset and lighting up times. Work out at what times Muslims would be eating and performing the five daily prayers.</p>	<p>I understand the Importance and rituals of the holy month of Ramadān and can describe these.</p>

What can be learned from the lives of significant people of faith?</p> <p>Role models.</p>	<p>LO: Know about the significance for Muslims of The Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) as Allāh’s final messenger and founder of the Muslim faith.</p>	<p>Know about the significance for Muslims of The Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) as Allāh’s final messenger and founder of the Muslim faith. Recognise and describe some key moments in The Prophet Muhammad’s life (pbuh).</p> <p>Retell a story of the life of Muhammad (pbuh) receiving Allāh’s message. Use a story board that does not use images of Muhammad.</p>	<p>I can tell you why Muhammad is a role model for the Islamic faith.</p>

How do I and others feel about life and the universe around us?</p> <p>Ultimate questions.</p>	<p>L.O: Identify some questions which are difficult to answer - Suggest answers to some difficult questions about life and the universe.</p>	<p>Identify some ultimate questions eg - Does God exist? - Why do bad things happen to good people? - What happens when we die? - What is the purpose of life? - What is our responsibility for looking after our world? (Global warming).</p> <p>Find out what answers Muslims might give to some of these questions and make posters with words and pictures to convey a Muslim view of life and the universe.</p>	<p>I can list some Islamic beliefs.</p>
