Rhyme and Poem time

We have a rhyme and poem session every day. We follow the poetry basket and will send the rhyme and poem home each week.

We love learning songs and rhymes linked to out topics.

- Library day is each Monday your child will choose a book for you to read and share with them. We will arrange drop-in library sessions.

Just a few things we will be covering this term:

- Winter signs/ what winter looks like/ feels like. Ice, frost, snow
- The North and South Pole- animals and what it is like.
- Chinese New Year why is it celebrated, what happens.
- Why do we love others/ caring for others.
- Traditional tales including The three little pigs, The 3 Billy Goats Gruff, Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, The Gingerbread man. We will be retelling the stories through drama and literacy.
- Easter the story and celebrations

Maths

- Counting and how many up to 10
- Comparing two groups of objects
- Adding two groups together
- Using the language of measure capacity, heavier and lighter, measuring height, shorter and longer, taller and shorter and measuring ingredients
- Number bonds to 10
- Days of the week and time
- Saying 1 more and 1 less than a given number to 10.

Phonics

Just to share some information about phonics and what your child will be learning in phonics. After children have learnt their individual sounds they will move on to special friends, e.g. sh, th, ch,ng.

- They will continue to learn to blend and sound talk using these letters and special friends to read and write the words.
- Children are starting to write independent sentences using key words and Fred talk.
